#### Main Landing Page

On the main landing page (<u>http://hagueacademy.brillonline.com/main</u>) you will find links to the publications included in this product.



When clicking on either of the titles you will find the opening page for the specific title. On each opening page you will find a link **Related publications** which returns you to the page with all publications.



#### Browsing

The opening page of the Collected Courses shows three tabs, for:

- Courses by Volume: provides an chronological overview of all collected courses back to volume 1, 1923.
- Courses by Author: provides an alphabetical overview by author of all collected courses back to volume 1, 1923.
- About the Hague Academy Collected Courses.

#### Searching

All **searches** may be conducted from the **Basic Search Box**, which is always located at the top of the screen. Simple queries are the best. By default the search engine will look for all words individually (i.e. it will treat the query as a "Boolean AND").

When **searching** on "**Grotius**" from the Basic Search Box, you will find **580 results** from the *Collected Courses*, which can be sorted by Relevance, Newest or Oldest titles.

#### Search tools

Registering for a personal account\* on the platform will allow you to enhance your search experience by taking advantage of several search tools. These tools will appear as soon as you have created a personal account.

Tools include:

**Save this search**: Perform a search and click on Save this search in the righthand menu. You can save as many searches as you like. Open your account to see and manage your saved searches.

**Search history:** When on the 'your account' page you also see your search history. The website records search history for 30 days.

**Search alerts:** Set up search alerts to get automatic notifications whenever a (new) article is published that will fit a certain query. E.g. a search alert for "arms control" will send you an e-mail when a new search result for the search "arms control" is found.
